



## **KLAMATH COMMUNITY COLLEGE ADMISSION APPLICATION**

### **1. APPLY FOR ADMISSIONS**

Complete the application form and return it to the Student Services Department in Building 3 on the KCC campus.

### **2. FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION**

Students interested in financial aid must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form available on line at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov). If you need assistance, there are computers available in Building 3 and financial aid personnel who can help you complete the application. Please note that all students interested in financial aid must have a high school diploma, GED, or achieve an acceptable score on the COMPASS placement test. For more information about scholarship opportunities, you may visit the Klamath Community College Website.

### **3. TAKE THE COMPASS PLACEMENT TEST**

The test is required for all new students who are entering a degree or certificate program, enrolling for more than six credits, receiving financial aid, taking a math or language skills class, or a class with a math or language skills prerequisite. COMPASS testing is offered on campus in Building 4 in the Learning Resource Center.

### **4. MEET WITH A STUDENT SUCCESS REPRESENTATIVE**

A Student Success Representative can help you plan a course of study that will help you achieve your goals at KCC. If you have credits from other colleges, bring copies of your grades or unofficial transcripts with you to the advising session. You may request an official transcript evaluation to ensure that prior credits are recognized by KCC. Please have your official transcripts sent to KCC in order to start this process. Student Success Representatives are located in Building 3 on campus.

### **5. ATTEND NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION**

The orientation will give you tips and information about making the most of your college experience. You will have the opportunity to meet other new students, hear from current students about their experiences, take a tour of the campus, and learn about resources available to assist you while at KCC.
