The Klamath Community College (KCC) aviation airplane program uses two (2) Cessna C-172N/M airplanes for most of the airplane courses and one (1) Piper PA28R Arrow airplane which is used for the complex aircraft requirements of the Commercial Pilot Course (AVS 207F). These aircraft are leased from KCC's partner Precision Aviation Training (PAT), LLC.

Due to poor weather, an increase in the number of airplane students, and a lack of Cessna aircraft availability, PAT is willing to utilize the Piper PA28R Arrow as a substitution for the Cessna C-172 aircraft to ensure aircraft availability to airplane students. The PA28R substituted will adequately meet the training requirements for the courses in which it will be used. This substitution option is under the express understanding that the Piper Arrow's hourly rates for all courses (with the exception of 11.5 hours of complex flight training in AVS 207F course) will use C-172s hourly rates. The course fee costs, established in both the 2019-2020 In-House and Contracted Veterans Information Bulletins, will not change. This substitution option will be in effect through the remainder of the 2019-2020 Catalog Year.
