- Represent the public interest
- Establish policies that define the institutional mission and set prudent, ethical, and legal standards for college operations
- Assure the Board of Education operates in an open, accessible, welcoming spirit, and maintains a culture that supports the College's commitment to diversity, equity and inclusion
- Hire and evaluate the College President
- Delegate power and authority to the College President to effectively lead the College
- Assure fiscal health and stability
- Monitor institutional performance and educational quality
- Advocate for and protect the College
