Return to Title IV (R2T4)

It has come to our attention that you received a zero GPA by either withdrawing from or failing all of your courses. Due to this, federal regulations require the financial aid office to re-calculate your financial aid eligibility and possibly return a portion of the financial aid you received to the Department of Education. If our office was required to return a portion of your financial aid, you will be receiving an email soon detailing the amount that was returned and instructions on how to repay this debt to the institution. Please note that if you are enrolled, you may be dropped from your classes if any returned funds are not paid to the institution.

Because of your zero GPA, you have also been disqualified from receiving additional financial aid funds until you file a student appeal form and it is approved. This form can be found on our website or picked up in the lobby of building 9.
