

Associate of Applied Science at Klamath Community College Articulated with the BA/BS degree in Digital Cinema at Southern Oregon University

2020/21 Academic Year

About the Program

The Associate of Applied Science (AAS) in Digital Media Design has been developed with the cooperation and support of Southern Oregon University (SOU). The degree is fully articulated with SOU's Digital Cinema program and allows students to transfer directly as juniors at Southern Oregon University with no loss of credits to pursue a bachelor's degree.

Students should contact the SOU Digital Cinema program early in the first year of their KCC AAS program to be advised about additional requirements and procedures for admission to the school or program.

Students should be aware that if they transfer before completing this degree, their courses will be evaluated individually toward the general education requirements in effect at SOU.

Entry Requirements

Students are required to take the college placement test to determine skill level and readiness indicated by test scores. As part of their training program, students must begin with the courses within their skill levels as determined by placement test scores. In addition, students may also be required to enroll in classes that would increase their employability and success.

Students who graduated from high school or completed a high school equivalency program in 1997 or after must have the following requirement for admission to a four-year Oregon state college or university: 1) two years of the same high school-level language, or 2) two terms of college-level language with a grade of "C-" or better (may be first-year language which can be used as elective credits). Students planning to complete a Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree at a four-year school will be required to complete the equivalent of one year of study of a foreign language at the second-year level (or above) before graduation.

Advanced Standing

Coursework from accredited colleges and universities will be accepted in accordance with college policies. A maximum of 24 "Professional/Technical" credits are transferable to SOU, and will be counted as elective credit. To ensure coursework is current, program courses over 5 years old must be reviewed and approved by the appropriate department head before being accepted toward course requirements.

Graduation Requirements

The Associate of General Studies degree through KCC will be awarded to students who complete all credits in this program with a grade of "C" or better. Some required courses may be graded on a pass/no pass basis. A grade of "P" for these courses indicates a student earned a "C" or better grade.

The Bachelor of Science degree requires two courses (7 or more credits) of math, designated programming, statistics, or logic courses. The second course may be completed at KCC or SOU. Please see your advisor for more details.

Humanities 9-12 credits

The AAS degree at RCC includes several approved elective courses that can satisfy the SOU lower division Humanities requirement. These courses are listed under the heading, "Recommended courses to complete at KCC"

The Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree requires completion of 1 year of the same foreign language at 2nd year level or above, or 4 years of the same foreign language in high school (C- or better), or successful completion of a proficiency exam. Second year foreign language may simultaneously count for Humanities and the BA requirements.

Recommended courses to complete at KCC

It is highly recommended students work closely with an KCC advisor to choose courses to complete the AAS degree. The information below can help you to determine what electives to take. Note some courses are required for the AAS degree and others may be taken as electives.

MMT 260/L Video Production 1, MMT 261/L Video Production 2 and MMT 296 Community Outreach transferred together will meet SOU Digital Cinema required courses DCIN 101,102, and 103 and DCIN 203 Cinema Production.

MMT 240/L will transfer as COMM 344 Media Photography but will not count towards the 60 upper division credits needed to earn a BS/BA at SOU but the credits will apply to the overall degree requirement of 180 credits. COMM 344 is an approved elective for the BA/BS in Digital Cinema at SOU.

ENG 195 Film Studies: Film as Art will transfer to SOU as DCIN 202 History of Cinema and can be used towards the Humanities requirement at SOU.

WRI 241 Creative Writing – Fiction Workshop will transfer to SOU as CW 281 Introductory Fiction and can be used towards the Humanities requirement at SOU. Students who choose to complete this course at KCC will not be required to take SOU’s DCIN 200 Storytelling Foundations.

THR 141 Fundamentals of Acting Technique I will transfer to SOU as TA 246 Intro to Acting. TA 246 is an approved elective for the BA/BS in Digital Cinema at SOU and can be used towards the Humanities requirement at SOU.

SPE 228 Rhetoric of Media will transfer as COMM 203 Media Literacy. COMM 203 is an approved elective for the BA/BS in Digital Cinema at SOU can be used towards the Humanities requirement at SOU.
