

## Placement

Which math class the student begins with is either based on their previous course work or placement after taking the MyMathTest.

- If the student places in MTH 010 – 070 and feels their placement is too low, they can take MTH 052, a lab where the student reviews material to improve their placement.
- Students who have taken MTH 065 or MTH 070, can then take MTH 105.
- Students who place into MTH 020 or MTH 070, should take MTH 104 and MTH 105 in the same term.
- Students who place higher than MTH 070, can take MTH 105 without taking MTH 104.
