**Students must submit Dual Credit registration forms to the Dual Credit H.S. Instructor by the specified “Registration Due Dates” to be eligible to receive KCC credit**

**\*\*\*\*\*All dates with an asterisk match with KCC Academic Calendar dates\*\*\*\*\***

Any student wishing to drop a dual credit class is responsible for doing so by the specified “Drop Date” for each term. The student must submit a drop form to the Dual Credit high school instructor with the student and instructor’s signature. A drop will not show on the student’s KCC transcript nor affect the KCC GPA. If a student has missed the drop due date, the course will be recorded on his/her KCC transcript.

A student may request a withdrawal from a course according to the specified “Withdraw Date.” The withdraw date is later than the drop date. The course will be recorded on the KCC transcript as a “W” (Withdraw) grade, which will not affect the student’s KCC GPA. The student must submit a withdraw form to the high school instructor with the student’s and instructor’s signature. If the student misses the withdrawal due date, he/she will be responsible for the course and the grade earned will be recorded on the KCC transcript.

***The designated dates for the entry of grades are key important dates to remember as those dates are the ONLY dates that entry of grades may be completed in the system for the term your dual credit course falls in too.
