### **Step 1: Submit your application**

#### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

- Completed application
- **\$50** non-refundable application fee
- Copy of valid passport; and Medical Release Form

- Financial/Bank Statement in English showing at least US \$18,000 for one academic year (3 Quarters) of study for the applicant. Documents must be dated within the past 60 days.

The Financial/ Bank Statement may include checking, savings accounts, stocks, certificates of deposit or other easily liquidated assets. Please indicate, if applicable, the relationships between sponsor and student on the bank statement.

- English proficiency scores
- Submit your secondary school transcripts (evaluated international transcripts)
- Applicant must be 16 years of age by the program start date

## ENGLISH PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

International students whose native language is not English are required to submit proof of English Proficiency. We will accept the following:

- TOEFL iBT overall score of 54 or higher
- IELTS overall score of 5.5 or higher, with no band lower than 5.0
- Official ACT score of 14 in ELA (English Language Arts with completed writing section)
- Official SAT Score of, not lower than, English Language Arts 410 and Math 430
- Cambridge General Certificate of Education (GCE) with C in English as First Language, or B in English as Second Language
- Pearson Test of English Academic (PTE) with a score no lower than 46
- STEP/EIKEN score of Grade Pre-1 or better
- Cambridge International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) in English as First Language with score of C or higher, or English as Second Language with a score of B
- Duolingo score no lower than 90
- iTEP (International Test of English Proficiency) Academic score of 4.5 or higher
- GTEC (Global Test of English Communication) score of 1095 or higher
- Completion of appropriate ESL level at the following schools:
  - EF International Language School – Completion of all B2 levels or Institutional TOEFL or iBT Report
  - Eurocentres Canada (Vancouver/Toronto and San Diego – Scale of Proficiency Level 6
  - ELS Language Schools – Level 109, Advanced or Institutional TOEFL Report
  - Converse International Language School – Completion of Level B2
  - FLS – Level 14
  - Kaplan International English Programs – Advanced Level Completion Letter
  - Embassy CES – Intermediate Level
  - St. Giles International English Language Academy – Level 6
- At least one year of High School or post-secondary education where English is the primary language of instruction, with passing grades

## **Step 2: Receive 1-20 Form**

After we receive your complete application with all required documents, an admission packet will be created for you. This will contain a KCC acceptance letter and your 1-20, which is an official document that contains your acceptance as an international student in the United States of America.

## **Step 3: F-1 or M-1 Visa Interview**

You must present the completed admissions package to the U.S. Consular Office nearest you, be sure to you have paid your [SEVIS and visa fee online](#). The wait time for an interview varies from country to country. Check the US State Department website to learn more about preparing the Visa application.

## **Step 4: Arrival in the United States of America**

Once you receive your F-1 or M-1 visa, please email us at [KCC-Int-Admissions@Klamathcc.edu](mailto:KCC-Int-Admissions@Klamathcc.edu) so that we can plan for your arrival. When you enter the US, you will need to show the immigration officer:

- Your I-20 form
- Your passport with a valid student visa

Please go to Arrival and Airport Pickup for more information.

New international students who are attending Klamath Community College and using a Klamath Community College I-20 to enter the USA must:

- Report in person to Klamath Community College's orientation for new international students

- Enroll and attend the first quarter at Klamath Community College
- Present originals of: passport, visa and Klamath Community College's I-20
- **Carry Health Insurance** while enrolled at Klamath Community College.
