- **English Proficiency (one of the following):**
Native language: English - or previous studies taught in English (minimum 2 years) or
TOEFL > 80 - or TOEIC > 750 - or IELTS > 6.0 or Cambridge Proficiency Exam > B2

French law requires an official valid test with a minimum score of TOEIC ≥ 785, TOEFL ≥ 80 or IELTS ≥ 6,5 for graduation, regardless of nationality.

01 CONFIRM ENROLLMENT AND PAY DEPOSIT TIMELINE: ONGOING UNTIL JULY

1. **Complete Enrollment Confirmation Form:** Find and complete the Enrollment Confirmation Form under the [home tab of your application](#).
2. **Pay Deposit:** Use the link in your admissions letter to pay the deposit or upload your signed FAFSA Letter.

02 COMPLETE VISA APPLICATION TIMELINE: MAY-AUGUST

1. **Schedule Visa Appointment:** Schedule your visa appointment through VFS Global.

03 SECURE HOUSING TIMELINE: MAY-JULY

1. **Explore Housing Options:** Get familiar with the housing options on the Aloha page.

2. **Create an Account:** Create an account with one of the listed providers. A guaranteed profile is encouraged to secure housing faster.
3. **Apply and Respond Quickly:** Apply to many options and respond promptly to offers.

04 ADMINISTRATIVE REGISTRATION TIMELINE: JULY/AUGUST

1. **Claim Your Rennes SB Email:** Check your spam folder for "aloha@rennes-sb.com" if you haven't received it by July 15.
2. **Pay the CVEC Tax:** Pay the CVEC tax.
3. **Pay Remaining Tuition:** Pay your remaining tuition or complete the promissory note for FAFSA.
4. **Complete RISE Registration:** Complete your registration in the RISE system.

05 GETTING SETTLED TIMELINE: JULY - SEPTEMBER

1. **Open a French Bank Account:** Create a French bank account.

2. **Pay the CPAM Tax:** Pay the CPAM tax to get your health insurance card, the Carte Vitale.
3. **Register Your Visa:** Register your visa in France and start the residency permit process to make visa renewal easier.
4. **Schedule Your Arrival:** Schedule your arrival with the WEL'COME Association.
5. **Attend the Aloha Fair:** Attend the Aloha Fair and ask questions.
6. **Register for CAF Housing Reimbursement:** Register for the CAF housing reimbursement.
