

Dual Credit and Sponsored Dual Credit Program Course Delivery Policy Approved Modalities

The purpose of this policy is to outline the approved instructional delivery methods for KCC's Dual Credit and Sponsored Dual Credit programs. The intent is to ensure consistency, quality, and alignment with KCC's academic standards and student support capabilities.

This policy applies to all high school instructors, administrators, and KCC faculty and staff involved in the planning, approval, and delivery of Dual Credit courses.

Klamath Community College does not support the use of Hybrid or HyFlex instructional modalities for Dual Credit courses. All Dual Credit courses must be delivered in the following approved formats:

- In-person (face-to-face) instruction at the high school

Definitions of Hybrid, HyFlex, Dual Credit and Sponsored Dual Credit programs

- Hybrid – A course that combines in-person and online instruction, with required attendance in both formats.
- HyFlex: A course that allows students to choose between attending in-person, online synchronously, online asynchronously, or any combination.
- Dual Credit and Sponsored Dual Credit programs– College-level courses taught at the high school by approved instructors, allowing students to earn both high school and college credit.
