

New High School Student Registration Form

High school students must complete the following steps to take classes at Klamath Community College.

- 1. Complete this form with required signatures from high school official and parent/guardian.
- 2. <u>If required</u> take a placement test prior to registration. Call (541) 880-2206 for a test appointment.
- 3. Make an appointment for an admissions interview with a Student Success Representative by calling (541) 882-3521. The student's parent or legal guardian must attend this interview with the student.

 Note: High school students are expected to meet Klamath Community College's Satisfactory Academic Progress Standards.

Students are required to complete a KCC Admissions application and a registration form.

Tuition is \$20 per credit plus \$12.50 per credit fees (Technology, Facility, and Student Government), \$5 I.D. fee and \$20 lab fee if required.
