1 FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

Students interested in financial aid must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form available on line at www.fafsa.gov. KCC's school code is 034283. If you need assistance, there are computers available in Building 3 and financial aid personnel who can help you complete the application. FAFSA processing takes approximately 12 weeks. Make sure you apply in plenty of time to ensure your aid is ready before the term begins. For more information about scholarship opportunities, you may visit the KCC Web site.

Please note that all students interested in financial aid must have a high school diploma or GED. KCC will need a certified copy to process your aid. GED transcripts can be ordered from https://ged.pearsoncred.com. For high school transcripts you will need to contact the school or district from which you graduated.

2 TRANSFER STUDENTS

If you have credits from another college, you must have your official transcripts sent to KCC in order to receive financial aid and register for classes. If you wish to transfer credits from another college to KCC you must request an official transcript evaluation to ensure that prior credits are recognized by KCC.

3 MEET WITH A STUDENT SUCCESS REPRESENTATIVE

Meet with a Student Success Advisor located in Building 3. At this time you will complete an Admission Application and register for New Student Orientation.

4 ATTEND NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

New Student Orientation is mandatory for all new students. During orientation you will take the COMPASS placement test, meet with an academic advisor to plan a course of study that will help you achieve your goals and register for classes. You will also receive tips and information about making the most of your college experience, take a tour of the campus, and learn about resources available to assist you while at KCC.
