STRATEGIC DIRECTION

200.0000

POLICY

The Board of Education shall establish and maintain the strategic direction of the College.

PURPOSE

The Board is the elected public body charged with establishing, developing, and maintaining Klamath Community College on behalf of the citizens of the District. The establishment, development and maintenance of KCC is viewed as the Board’s most important function. In performing that function, it will act on the best interests of the greater Community taking into account input from the Community and College Administration.

The Board finds that the major strategic decisions are embodied in State statute and rule. That is, Klamath Community College is a two-year community college operating within the Klamath Community College District. Programs may not exceed the Associate Degree level and shall be available to all high school graduates of the district and others who may benefit from the programs. Therefore, it is the Board’s intention to establish policy methods by which it can assure it maintains the institution’s strategic direction.

IMPLEMENTATION

<u>Values, Visions, and Mission</u>		205.0100
Values	The Values statement represents Community Values that are reflected in the District and College.	
Visions	The Vision statement articulates College characteristics that will reflect Community Values.	
Mission	The Mission statement clearly states the College’s purpose or function. Note: State statute and administrative rule establish the College as a two-year Community College providing educational services up to and including the Associates Degrees within the Klamath Community College District for high school graduates and others who may benefit from the programs.

Strategic Goals 205.0200

The Board will establish and regularly review progress on Strategic Goals, which are determined through the College's strategic planning process. The Administration is charged with implementing the Strategic Goals and providing regular progress reports.

Performance Indicators 205.0300

The Board will establish, based on administrative recommendation, such annual and/or five-year indicators of success as it may deem necessary for short-term institutional success and long-term development toward Strategic Goals.

Review of the Strategic Plan 205.0400

The Board shall regularly review its statement of Values, Vision, and Mission as well as the Strategic Goals, making modifications as necessary to reflect the changing needs of the District and the progress of the College. The Board's intent is to establish a process of continuous improvement.

Institutional Learning Outcomes 205.0500

The Institutional Learning Outcomes (ILOs) of Klamath Community College represent the core abilities which students acquire while studying at KCC.
